Treasurer's Report

The cash balances for January were \$\$372,189.77. The Checking account (line 1) and the General Savings account (line #2) decreased by a combined total of approximately \$10,000 used to pay bills and payroll. Receipts for expenses for January were \$769, the majority being from donations. Total expenses for January were \$11,511. The check register was \$12,245.45. The major expense in January was payroll. The NYSEG bill was higher than normal as the gas bill was for 3 months instead of the normal 2 and electric was higher due to less electricity being generated due to the weather. The January Check Register shows total disbursements of \$9,731.41. We are slightly ahead of budget at 45% while we are projected to be at 42%.
