We sold subscriptions for the Oxford Review Times and tickets for the All Star Review. Both were financially successful.

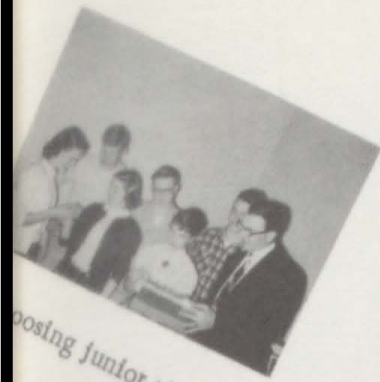
