






foreword

in appreciation

It is with much pleasure that we take this opportunity to show our appreciation to Mr. and Mrs. Lynn Padgett. They have given to the Academy fifty years of devoted service, --Mr. Padgett, thirty years and Mrs. Padgett, twenty years.

Mrs. Padgett, with only student help, fed seventy-eight students in the beginning; but by 1946 she had four women assisting her. She recalls that she used the same size of stove then that they are now using, although now over eight hundred are being fed.

To quote Mrs. Padgett, --"I could write a book about that place--sometimes I think I will. I bet it would be a best seller."

Over the years while Mrs. Padgett has been either the manager of the cafeteria or one of the staff working with her sister, Mrs. Walden, Mr. Padgett has looked after the children in a different way. "Way back when" -- he fired the furnace to keep them warm after having brought them to school in the bus.

When the new school was being built in 1930, it was Lynn who walked the beams as night watchman, kept the fires going, brought the children to school, went home to take a nap only to return to school to take the children home and at 10:00 P. M. begin his watch for another night.

During the day Lynn could be found running the movie projector. When there were evening affairs, it was Lynn who "saw to" the fires and locked up the school.

During the first three or four years of his service his work necessitated additional help so he personally employed his brother-in-law, Arthur Smith. Later, help was provided for him.


Tom Tansey has worked with Lynn for twenty years and is now replacing him as Head Mechanic in charge of bus transportation.


It has been a full life that each of these "school citizens" has given in loving service to Oxford Academy and Central School.

We are very proud that our president, George Hill, has been selected as one of the semi-finalists for the National Honor Scholarship. We wish him success in the final examination.















