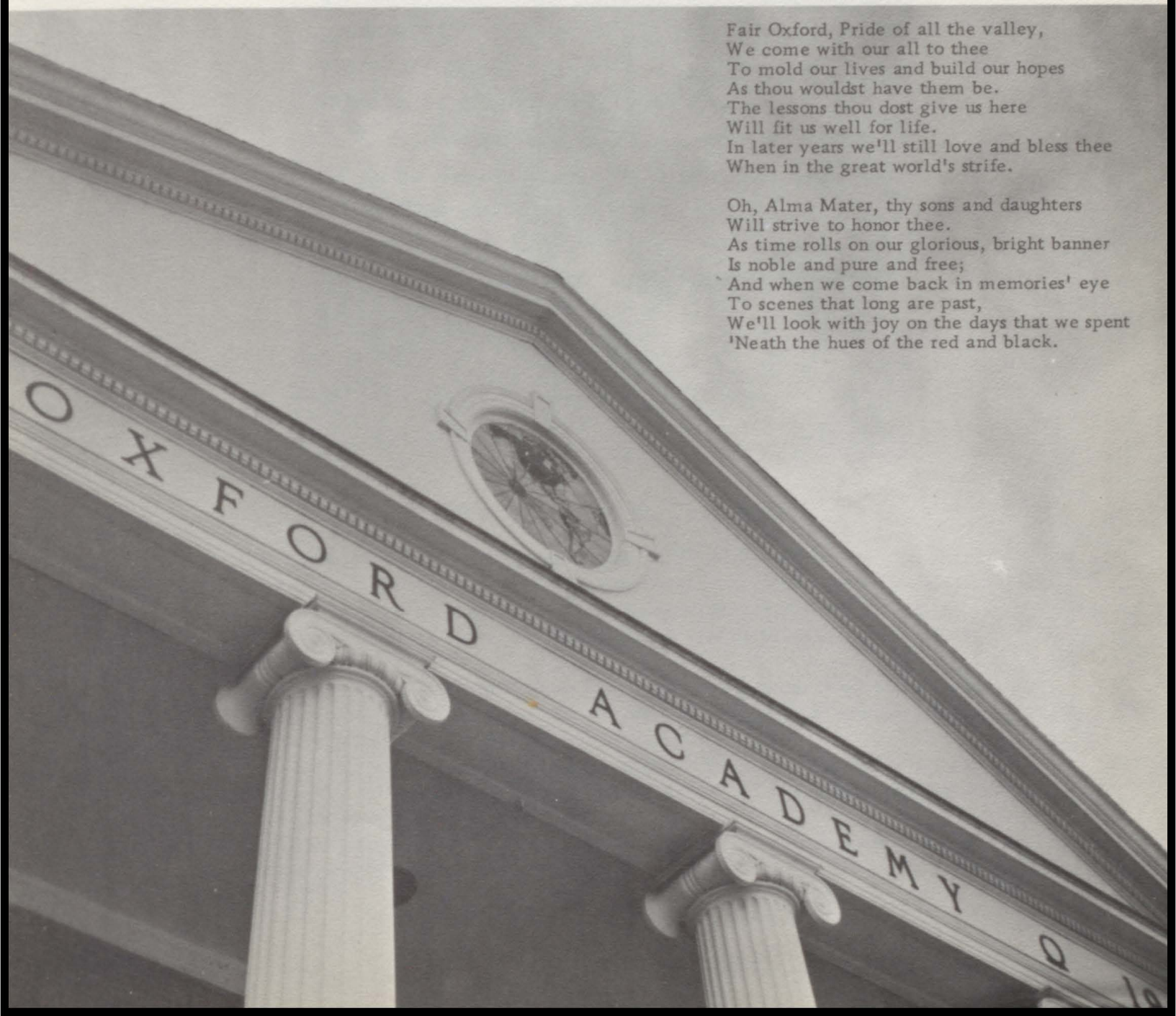
Foreword

In Appreciation



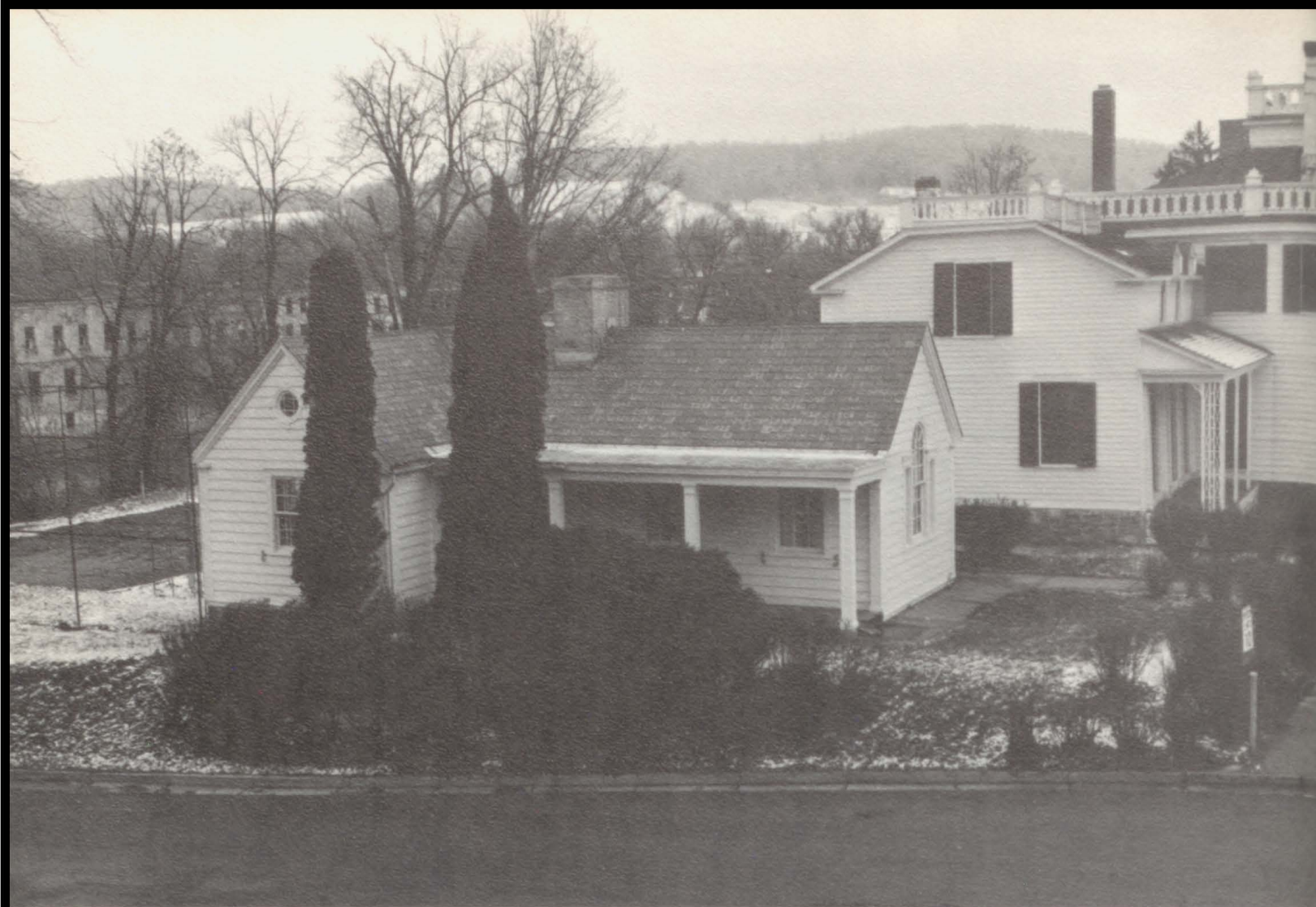
Mrs. Marion R. Jeffords

In reading the senior activities we take pleasure in realizing our participation in the principal organizations of the school in positions of leadership and honor.

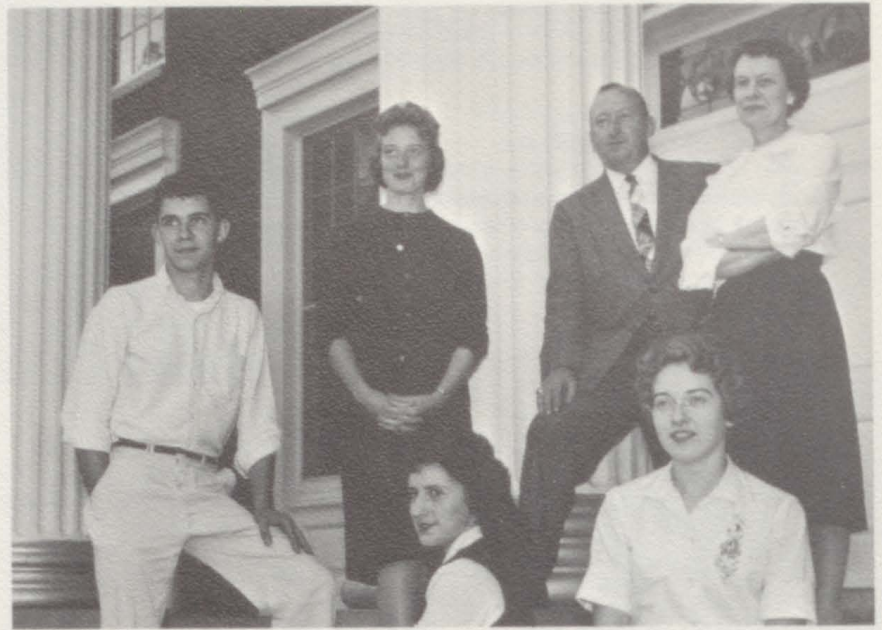
We also have two European travelers --Carol Stratton and Nancy Ford, who were members of the Christian Friendship Caravan in the summer of 1960.
