Because I am so separated from them, I have found their true value. Life is not so different compared to home — just another language buzzing around my ears (which, by the way, I'm getting fairly good at). School is, however, quite a bit different from little Oxford. I am attending Sweden's second largest gymnasium, a total of 2,000 students in the last three years of high school. I am in a class of 30 students and we attend all the same classes together, including the following: Swedish, physics, chemistry, biology, society, philosophy, math, religion and one of either French, English, or German. The science department is just fantastic and the labs are always a source of surprise and fun to me the equipment we can use and some of the methods of teaching. The relationships between teachers and students is on a businesslike basis, no joking or fooling around. There are no sports or clubs connected with the school either. In other words, school is kind of tiring and boring at times. HOWEVER, if you are placed among students as GREAT as the ones I know, fun can be made no matter what the situation.
