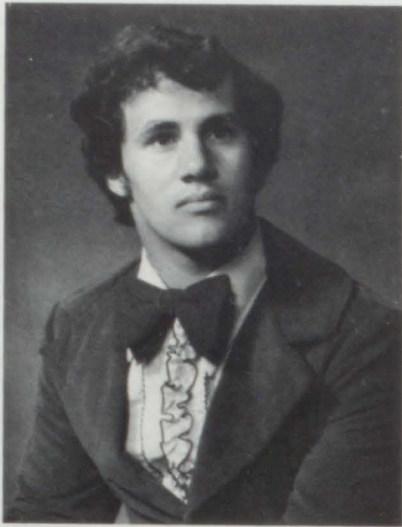
The weather here is hot all year round. My Christmas was sunny and in the 80°s; it was very nice. I did kind of miss the snow, which I hear you have a lot of this year.
