The American Legion Oratorical Contest is an annual event. It is open to any high school student who wishes to compete. Contestants must write an eight to ten minute speech on some aspect of the Constitution, and then give the speech from memory. Contests start at a local level, where you compete against people from your own school, and continue all the way up to the national level.

Participating in this contest improves your writing skills, broadens your knowledge of the government, and helps you become comfortable with public speaking. If that's not enough incentive, you also get prizes! Each level of competition rewards either cash or savings bonds to the winners.

I have competed in the Oratorical Contest since I was a freshman. At first it was pretty hard, but the more I did it the easier it became. Now, four years later, I am a two-time District Level Champion. I have made new friends from different schools, I have gained invaluable experience, and I have won a total of over \$2,700.

Academic "O" Recipients Make The Grade...

Student Leaders Have Done Their Away-From-Homework!

Every year Oxford sends students to several different programs which take place during the summer. Last year we sent people to the American Legion Boy's State at SUNY Morrisville, the American Legion Auxilliary Girl's State at Russell Sage College, the National Youth Leadership Conference in Washington DC, the Hugh O'Brien Youth Leadership Conference at LeMoyne College, and the Rotary Youth Leadership Conference at Hartwick College.

The Academic "O" is an award presented to students for outstanding academic achievement. In order to be eligible to receive this award, students must have earned a minimum of five academic credits during the previous school year and maintained an average of at least an 85. Students receive a chenille letter when they earn their first Academic "O" and receive a gold bar for subsequent years.

New Visions


