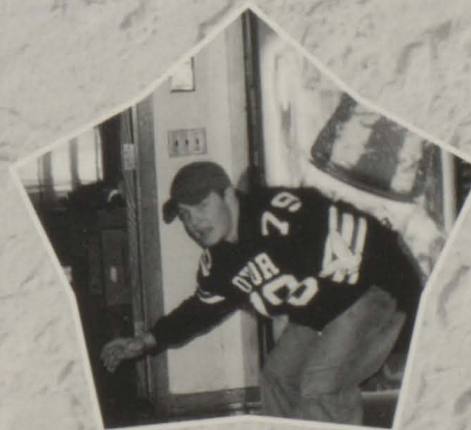

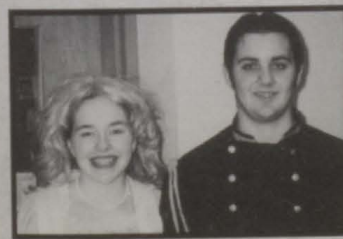
Into The Woods!

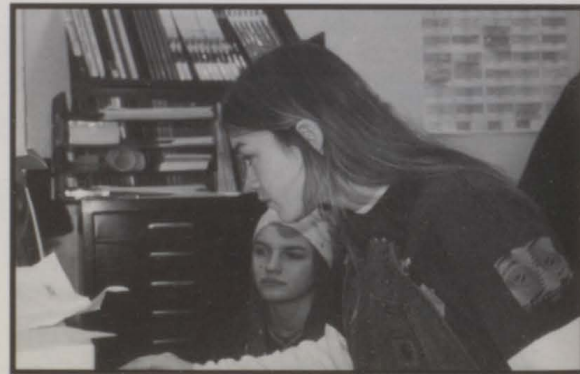
