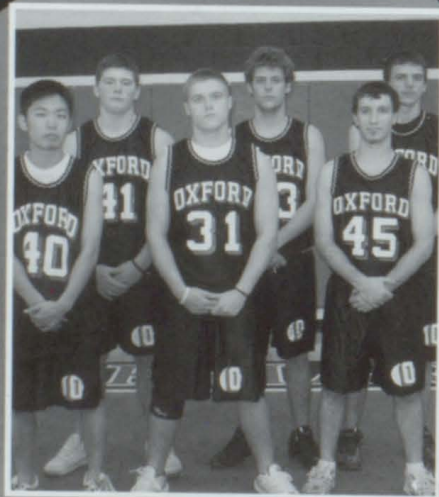

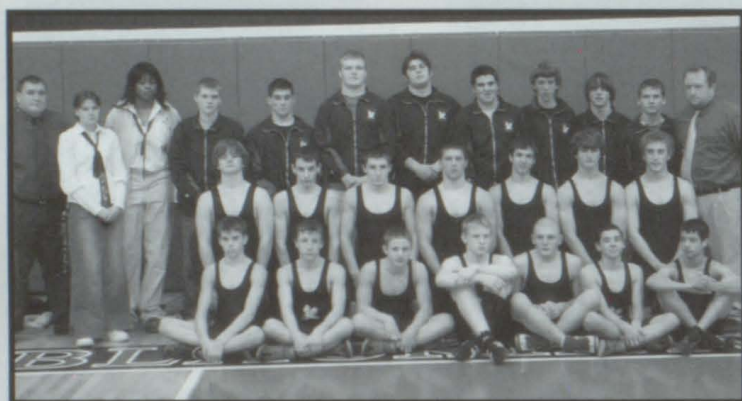

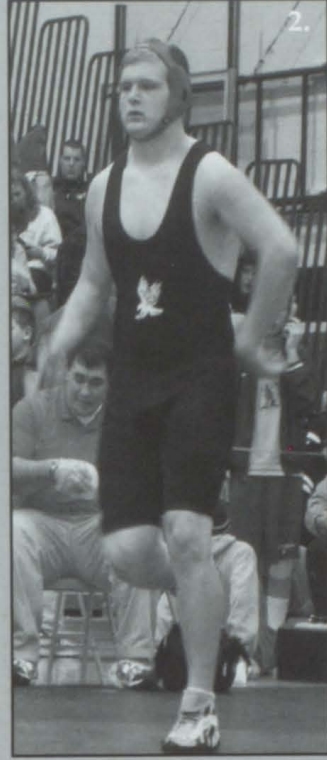

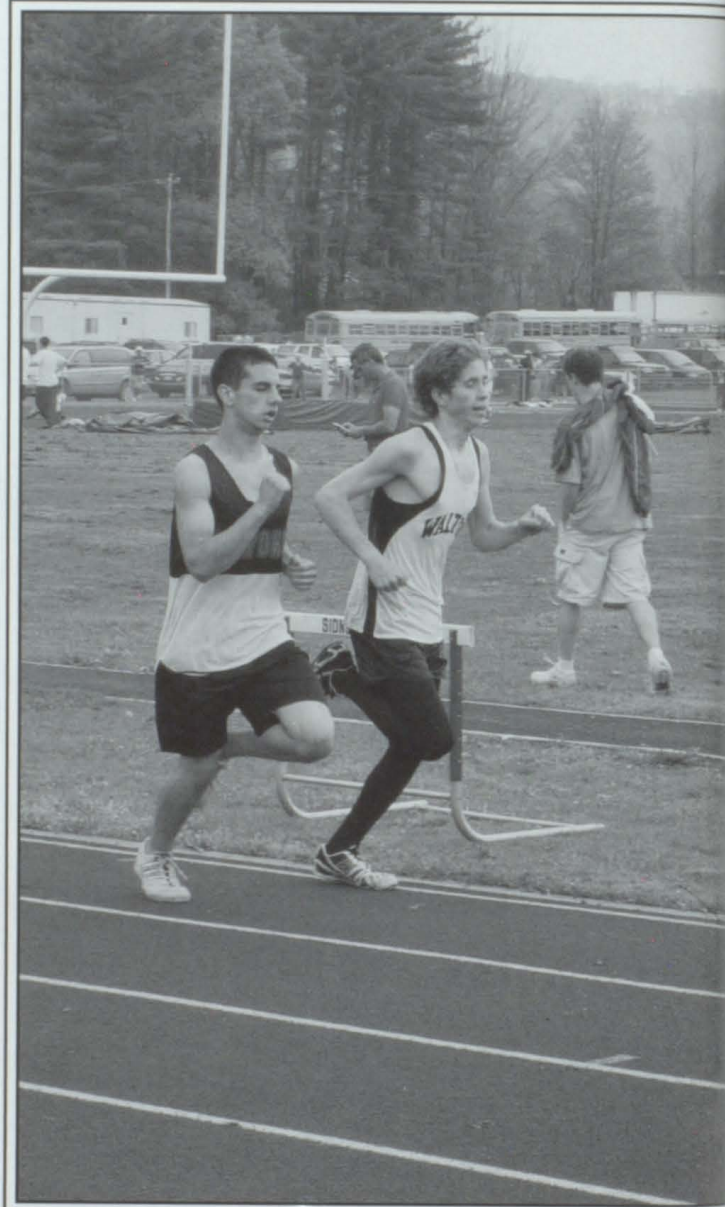

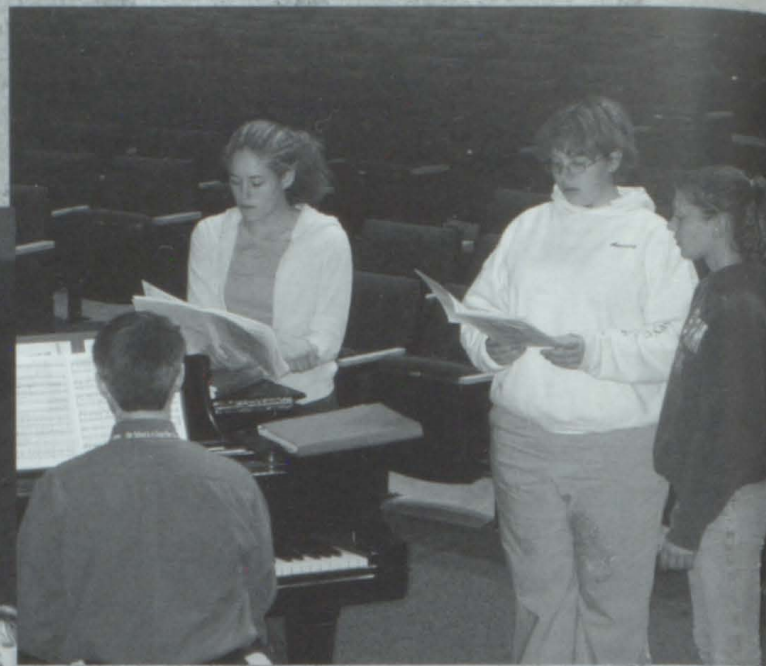


Accomplishments of the 2004 spring and summer marching season

Four person teams compete in answering questions about a wide range of subjects from history to science to sports, popular culture and more. Mock Trial Club is a club of 9th-12th grade students who compete with other mock trial clubs in other schools in our county. We receive one trial booklet with the charges, the trial story, and the witness statements. Our club then divides into defense and prosecution/plaintiff lawyers and witnesses and prepares cases for the defense and prosecution/plaintiff sides respectively. We then go to a competition with a defense, or prosecution/plaintiff, team— depending on which side the opposing school is taking. For example, if we compete against a mock trial club from Afton High School and they are taking defense, our prosecution/plaintiff team would face them.

We perform in real courtrooms— usually in Norwich— and usually in front of real judges. Individual team members are scored by their speaking clarity and how well organized they are in making their points. The judge scores each person with either a 1 (poor), 2 (good), or a 3 (very good) for each performance of questioning (by the lawyers) and responses (by the witnesses). The points are added up and the team with the most points wins that competition. There are three competitions. Usually, the team that scores the most points moves on to playoffs with other teams around the state. If a team continues to win, the team has a final contest in the courtroom of New York's highest court in Albany- Mr. Tarzia

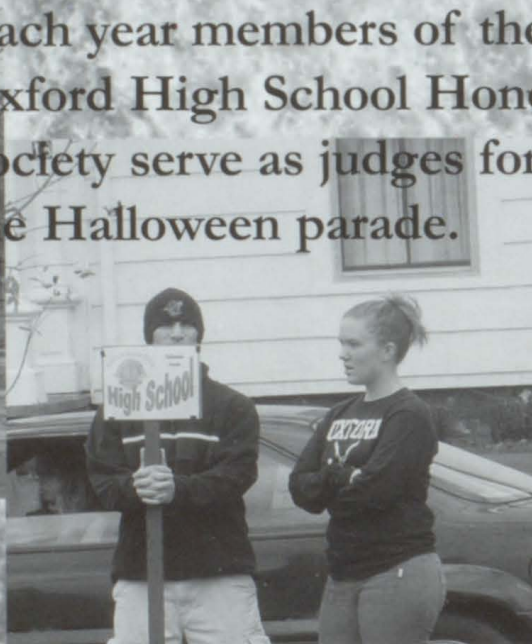
