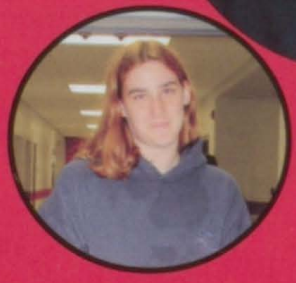
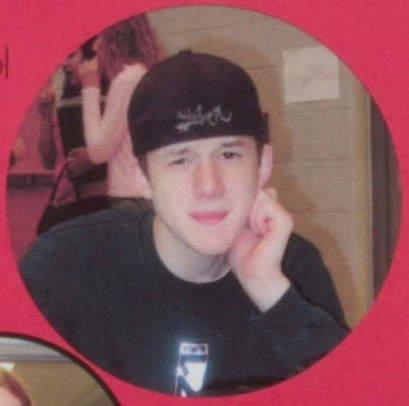
Joni Mitchell once sang, "Don't it always seem to go, that you don't know what you've got 'til it's gone...They paved paradise and put up a parking lot.."

That year, on Twin Day of Spirit Week, every teacher dressed as a construction worker. There were yellow helmets everywhere!

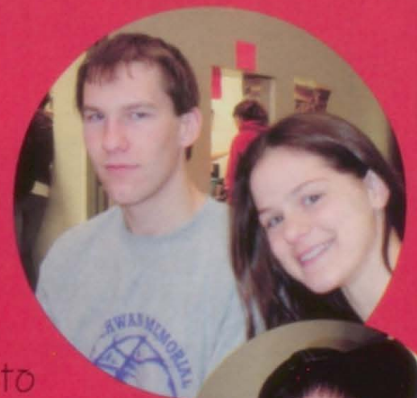

Many students and teachers, mainly this year's seniors, were worried that the new school wouldn't "feel" the same as the old one.

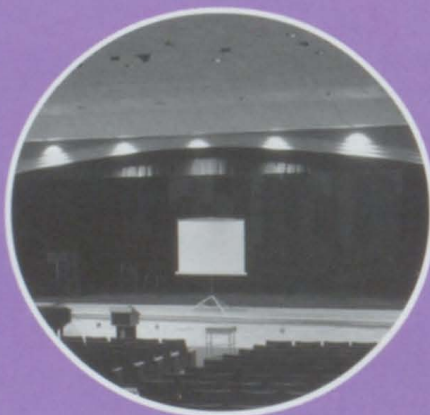

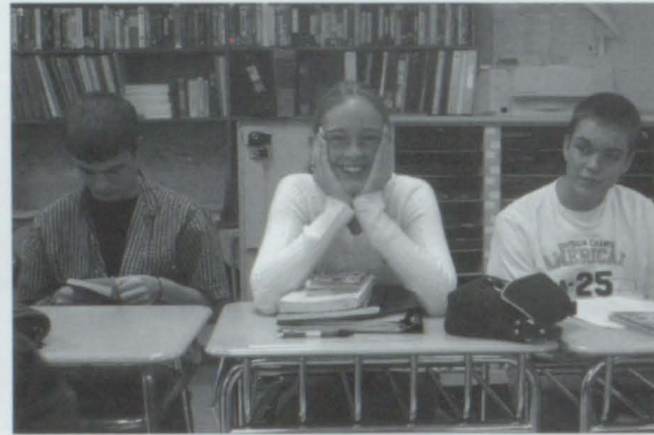
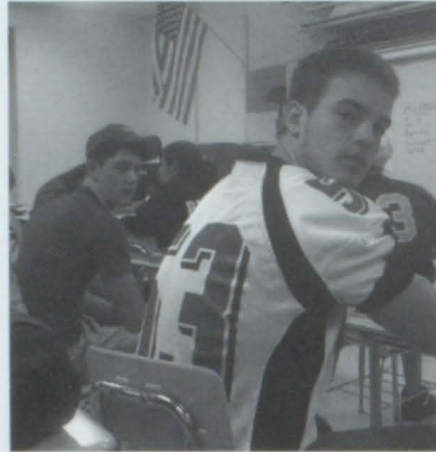
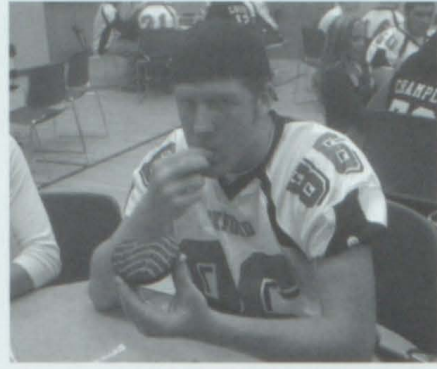
Old & New
