America marked the 10th anniversary of the attacks on the World Trade Center on September 11, 2011. Pictured in the middle and at right are the memorials built to honor those who perished.

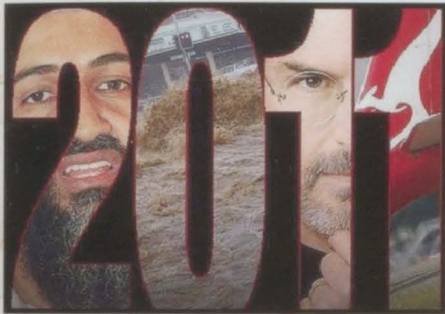
