I fell in love with the country side already. The life style in Oxford is so relaxed! The best thing is they have so many days off, like many holidays and there are snow days too! I experienced a lot of new things here, like the homecoming dance, volleyball team, bowling team, drama club, track, prom and had my first Sonic. I enjoyed many holidays and traditions of the United States.
