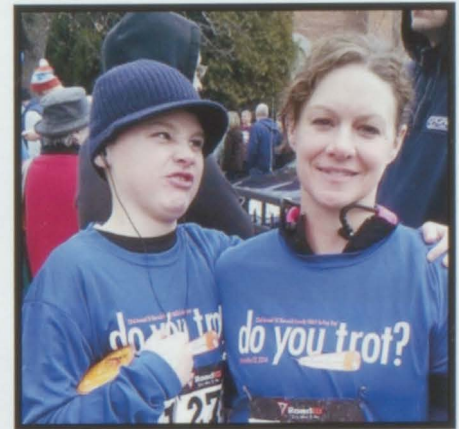
Faculty Leaving Their Mark

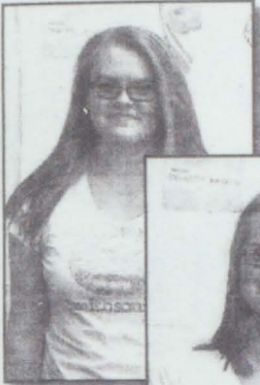


Beautiful Locks

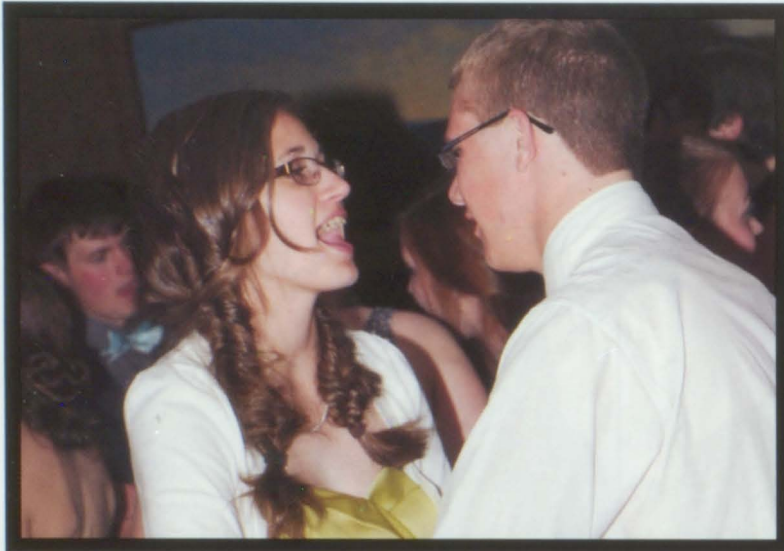
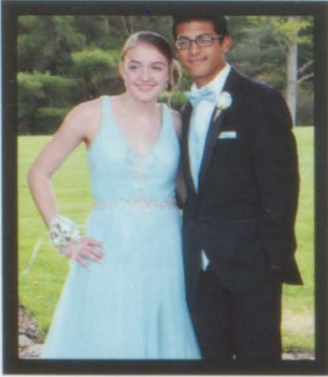
If you are interested in donating your hair, we will be hosting this event again next spring. As Patene says, "To us, it's hair, but to women with cancer, it's hope."



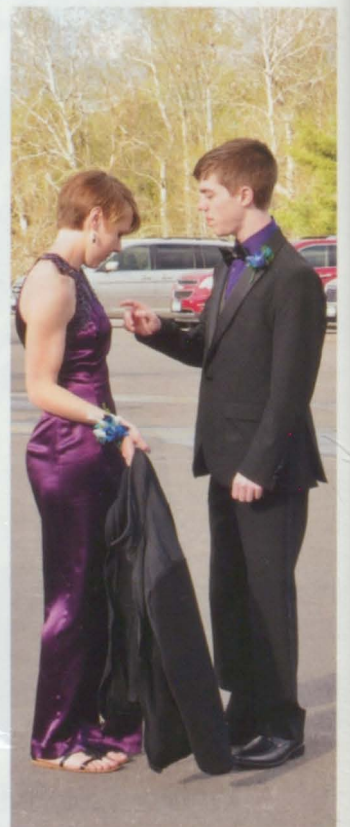

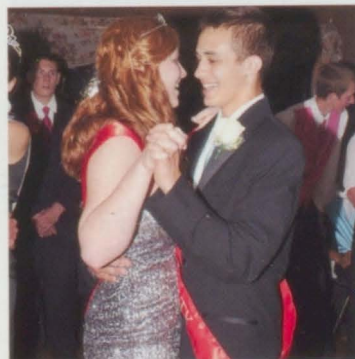

The demonstration really drives home the point of what can happen when students make destructive decisions while driving.



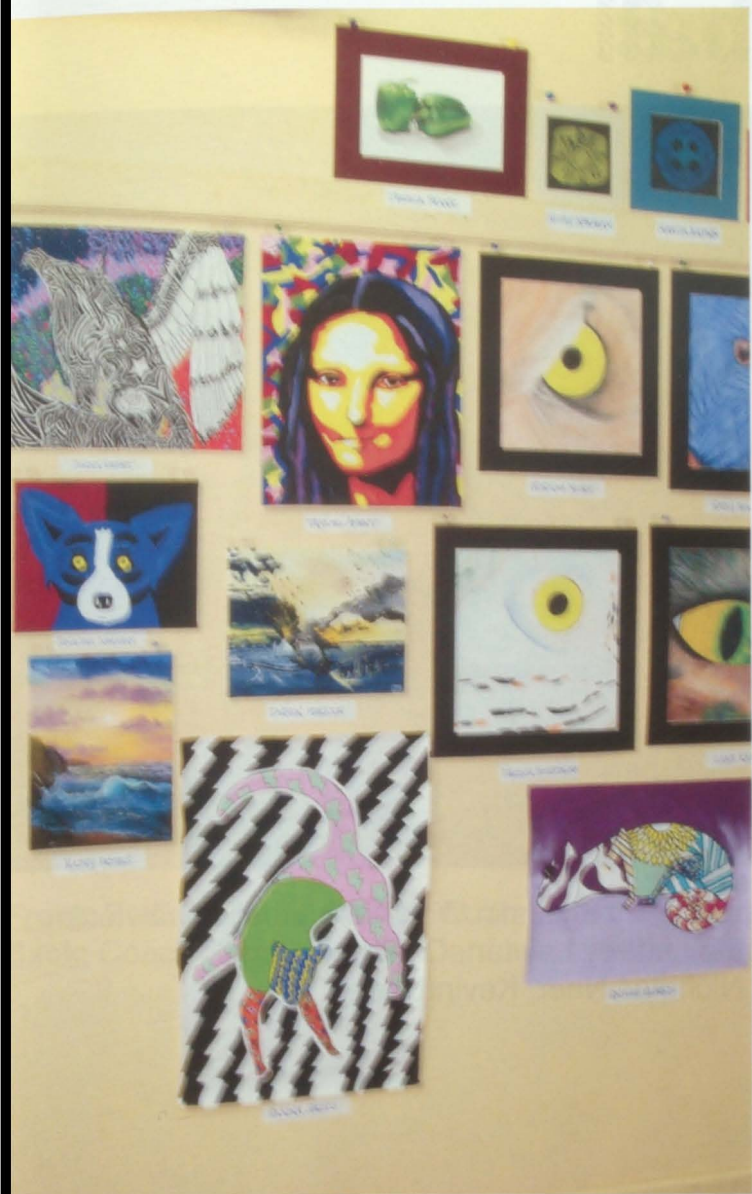

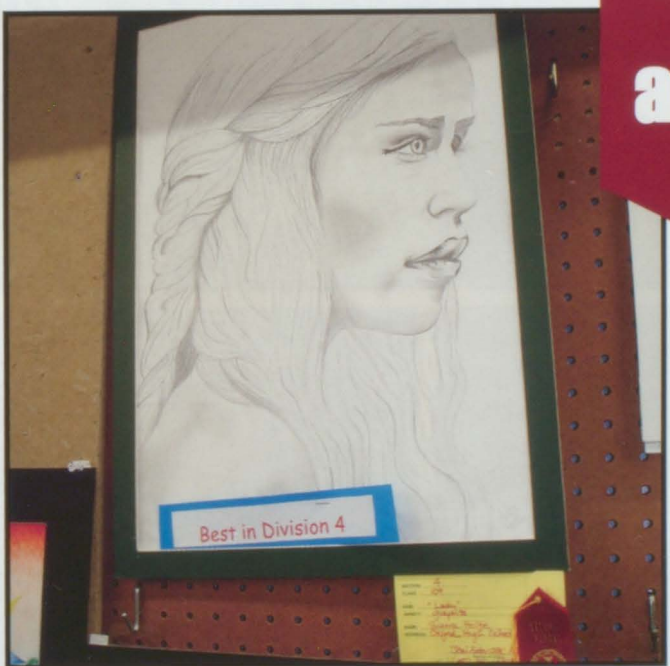
The High O'Brien Youth Center Leadership Seminar

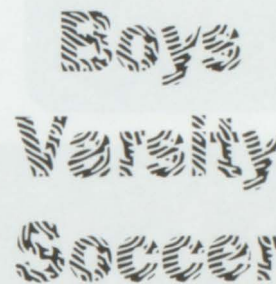
