Twiddle Muffs are fabulous for Dementia and Alzheimer patients and also for children with Autism.

My Ouma (grannie in S.A) had this awful disease before her passing, so this is dedicated to her.

If you are working your Twiddle Muff in thicker yarn, the pattern is worked in multiples of 4 and you can decrease your starting chain by 8 stitches to work a slightly smaller Twiddle Muff.

## MATERIALS

$>$ Any DK yarn of your choice.
$>4 \mathrm{~mm}$ hook.
$>$ Needle for sewing in ends.
> Ribbon
> Buttons
> Pom poms
> Fluffy Yarn
$>$ Crochet Motifs
> Charms and trinkets


## ABBREVIATIONS

| bpdc | back post double <br> crochet | Yo, insert your hook from back to front around <br> the post of the indicated stitch, complete dc as <br> normal. |

| ch | chain | crossed double <br> crochet |
| popcorn | Skip a stich, 1dc in the next stitch, 1dc in the <br> skipped stitch. |  |
| sc | Make 5 dc into the same stitch, remove hook <br> from last dc and insert it into both loops <br> of the 1st dc. Pick up the last dc with your hook <br> and pull through the 1st dc. Ch1 to <br> close the popcorn. |  |
| sk st/sts | skip a stitch/stitches | slip stitch |
| sl st | space/spaces | stitch/stitches | | 5 treble crochet |

## This pattern uses US terminology.

## This will be worked as a row. at the end you will join to form a ring. From Round 1 we will work in the round.

Ch 49 , work 1 dc into the 3 rd ch from the hook. 1 dc into each of the next 46 ch . Make sure your work is not twisted and join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st to form a ring. Stitch count: 48 dc

## ROUND 1

Ch2, (this counts as the 1st dc), 1dc into each of the next 47sts. Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Fasten off and secure ends.
Stitch count: 48 dc

## ROUNDS 2 AND 3

Join around the post of any st, ch2 (this counts as your 1st bpdc), 1bpdc into each of the next 47sts.
Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Fasten off and secure ends. Stitch count: 48bpdc

## ROUND 4

Join in any st, ch2 (this counts as the 1st dc), 1dc into each of the next 47sts.
Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Do not end off.
Stitch count: 48 dc

## ROUND 5

Ch2, (this counts as the 1st dc), 1dc into each of the next 47sts.
Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Do not end off.
Stitch count: 48 dc

## ROUND 6

Ch2, (this counts as the 1st dc), 1dc into each of the next 47sts.
Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Fasten off and secure ends.
Stitch count: 48 dc

## ROUND 7

Join in any st, ch2 (this counts as the 1 st dc), 1 dc into each of the next 2 sts.
*1 popcorn in the next st, 1 dc into each of the next 3sts.

* Repeat from *to* 11 more times. Popcorn into the last st. Join to the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Do not end off.
Stitch count: 12 popcorns, 36 dc


## ROUND 8

Note: Do not work the ch1-space used to close the popcorn in this round.
Ch2, (this counts as the 1 st dc), 1 dc into each of the next 47sts.
Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Fasten off and secure ends.
Stitch count: 48 dc

## ROUND 9

Join in any dc that is worked into the top of a popcorn, ch2 (this counts as the 1 st dc ), 1 dc into each of the next 2 sts. *1 popcorn in the next st, 1 dc into each of the next 3sts.

* Repeat from *to* 11 more times. Popcorn into the last st. Join to the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Do not end off.

Stitch count: 12 popcorns, 36 dc

## ROUND 10

Note: Do not work the ch1-space used to close the popcorn in this round.
Ch2, (this counts as the 1 st dc), 1 dc into each of the next 47sts.
Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Fasten off and secure ends.
Stitch count: 48 dc

## ROUND 11

Note: Try to add some yarn with texture on Rounds 11, 12 and 13.
Join in any st, ch2 (this counts as the 1 st dc), 1 dc into each of the next 47 sts .
Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Do not end off.
Stitch count: 48 dc

## ROUND 12

Ch2, (this counts as the 1 st dc), 1 dc into each of the next 47sts. Join to thetop of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Do not end off.
Stitch count: 48 dc

## ROUND 13

Ch2, (this counts as the 1st dc), 1dc into each of the next 47sts. Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Fasten off and secure ends.

## Stitch count: 48 dc

## ROUND 14

Join in any st, ch2 (this counts as the 1 st dc) work back and make 1 dc into the previous st.
*sk st, 1dc into the next st, 1dc back into the sk st. * Repeat from *to* 22 more times. Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Fasten off and secure ends
Stitch count: 24 crdc

## ROUNDS 15, 16 AND 17

Join in the dc to the left, in any cr dc, ch2 (this counts as your 1st dc), 1dc into the previous st. Work 1 cr dc into each of the cr dc's from Round 14. Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Fasten off and secure ends after Round 17. Stitch count: 24 crdc

## ROUND 18

Join in any st, ch2 (this counts as the 1 st dc), 1 dc into each of the next 47 sts. Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Do not end off.
Stitch count: 48 dc

## ROUND 19

Ch2, (this counts as the 1st dc), 1dc into each of the next 2sts. *5trc bobble in the next st, 1 dc into each of the next 3sts.* Repeat from *to* 10 more times. 5trc bobble in the last st. Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Fasten off and secure ends.
Stitch count: $12 \times 5$ trc bobbles, 36dc

## ROUND 20

Join in any st, ch2 (this counts as the 1st dc), 1dc into each of the next 47sts. Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Do not end off.
Stitch count: 48 dc

## ROUNDS 21-26

Note: If you feel that the Twiddle Muff is becoming a bit long you can decrease the amount of rounds worked here.
Ch2, (this counts as the 1st dc), 1dc into each of the next 47sts. Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Fasten off and secure ends after you have completed Round 26.
Stitch count: 48 dc

## ROUND 27

Join in any st, ch2 (this counts as the 1st dc), 1dc into each of the next 47sts. Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Do not end off.
Stitch count: 48 dc

## ROUND 28

Note: Don't worry too much about where your bobbles fall, this just adds to the texture of the Twiddle Muff.
Ch2, (this counts as the 1 st dc ), 1 dc into each of the next 2 sts . *5trc bobble in the next st, 1dc into each of the next 3sts.* Repeat from *to* 10 more times.
5 trc bobble in the last st. Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st.
Fasten off and secure ends.
Stitch count: $12 \times 5$ trc bobbles, 36dc bobbles, 36dc

## ROUND 29

Join in any st, ch2 (this counts as the 1 st dc), 1 dc into each of the next 47 sts. Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Do not end off.
Stitch count: 48 dc

## ROUND 30

Ch3, (this counts as the 1st dc and ch1)
*Sk st, 1dc into the next st, ch1.* Repeat from *to* 22 more times.
Join to the $2 n d$ ch of beginning ch3 with a sl st. Do not end off.
Stitch count: 24dc, 24 ch1-spaces

## ROUND 31

Ch2 (this counts as the 1st dc), work 1 dc into each st and ch1-sp. Join to the top of the beginning ch2 with a sl st. Do not end off.
Stitch count: 48 dc

## ROUND 32

Ch1 (this does not count as a st), 1sc into the same st. Work 1sc into each of the next 47sts. Join to the beginning sc with a sl st. Fasten off and secure ends. Stitch count: 48 sc
