## TWIDDLE MUFF

Needles 6.5 mm straight needles
Double knitting or chunky wool, (various textures are good)
Buttons, beads, ribbons, rings etc

## INSTRUCTIONS

## CUFF

Cast on 40sts using either one strand of chunky wool or two strands of double knitting wool

Work in stocking stitch (knit a row, purl a row) for 11 inches (28cm). This forms the inside of the muff.

## MUFF BODY

Continue knitting in stocking stitch and various patterns until work measures 23 inches ( 58.5 cm ). Cast off.

## FINISHING

Right sides together (purl sides facing you) sew the long edges together.
Turn the muff inside out (knit side facing you), push the cuff up inside the muff body and sew the cast on stitches to the cast off stitches.

Decorate with buttons, beads, ribbons, rings etc making sure everything is sewn on tight so that they cannot be pulled off and that there are no loose threads.

## PATTERN IDEAS

## Stocking Stitch

1st row - knit to end
2nd row - purl to end repeat these rows to form pattern

## Garter Stitch

knit every row

## Moss Stitch

1st row - knit 1, purl 1, repeat to end
2nd row - purl 1, knit 1, repeat to end
Repeat these rows to form pattern

## Rib

knit 1, purl 1, repeat to end
Repeat these row to form pattern

## Double Rib

1st row - knit 2, purl 2, repeat to end 2nd row - purl 2, knit 2, repeat to end Repeat these rows to form pattern

## Drop Rib stitch

1st row - (wrong side) purl to end
2nd row - slip 1, *knit 1B, purl 1,* repeat from * to end
Repeat these rows to form pattern
knit 1B - knit into loop below next stitch on left hand needle and slip off needle.

## Basket weave stitch

1st row - knit to end
2nd row - *knit 5, purl 3* repeat to end
3rd row - *knit 3, purl 5* repeat to end
4th row - *knit 5, purl 3* repeat to end
5th row - knit to end
6th row - knit 1, *purl 3, knit 5* repeat from * to last 7 stitches, purl 3, knit 4
7th row - purl 4, *knit 3' purl 5* repeat from * to last stitch purl 1
8th row - knit 1, *purl 3, knit 5* repeat from * to last 7 stitches, purl 3, knit 4
8 rows form pattern.
