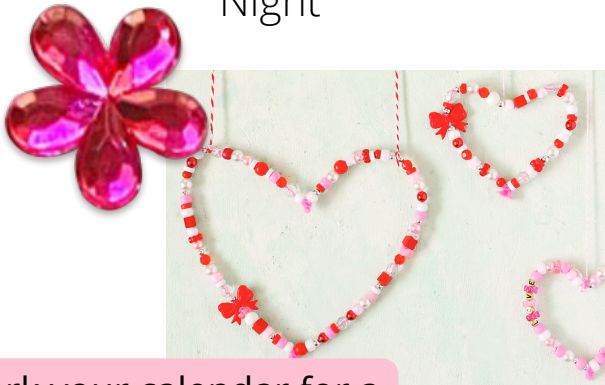

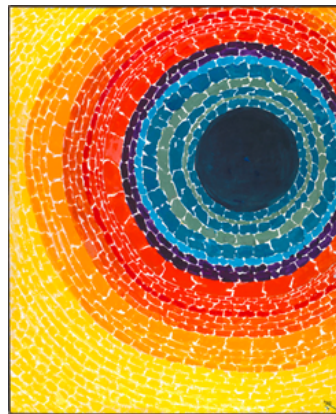
After 31 years at the Oxford Memorial Library, I am both excited and sad to announce that Nancy Wilcox will be retiring from Library Director.
