# Oxford Memorial Library

## Annual Report for 2024



The Oxford Memorial Library is located on the site of an ancient Indian fort on Fort Hill Park in the picturesque village of Oxford.

Theodore Burr, built this Federal style house between 1809-1811. Burr's home was later occupied by the families of Ira Wilcox, Oxford merchant, from 1814-1873; Benjamin Cannon, lawyer, 1873-1890; served as the Rectory for St. Joseph's Church 1890-1899. In 1900, the house with its grounds was dedicated as a free public library given to Oxford in memory of Eli Lyon Corbin and Abigail Taintor Corbin, his wife, by their children.
